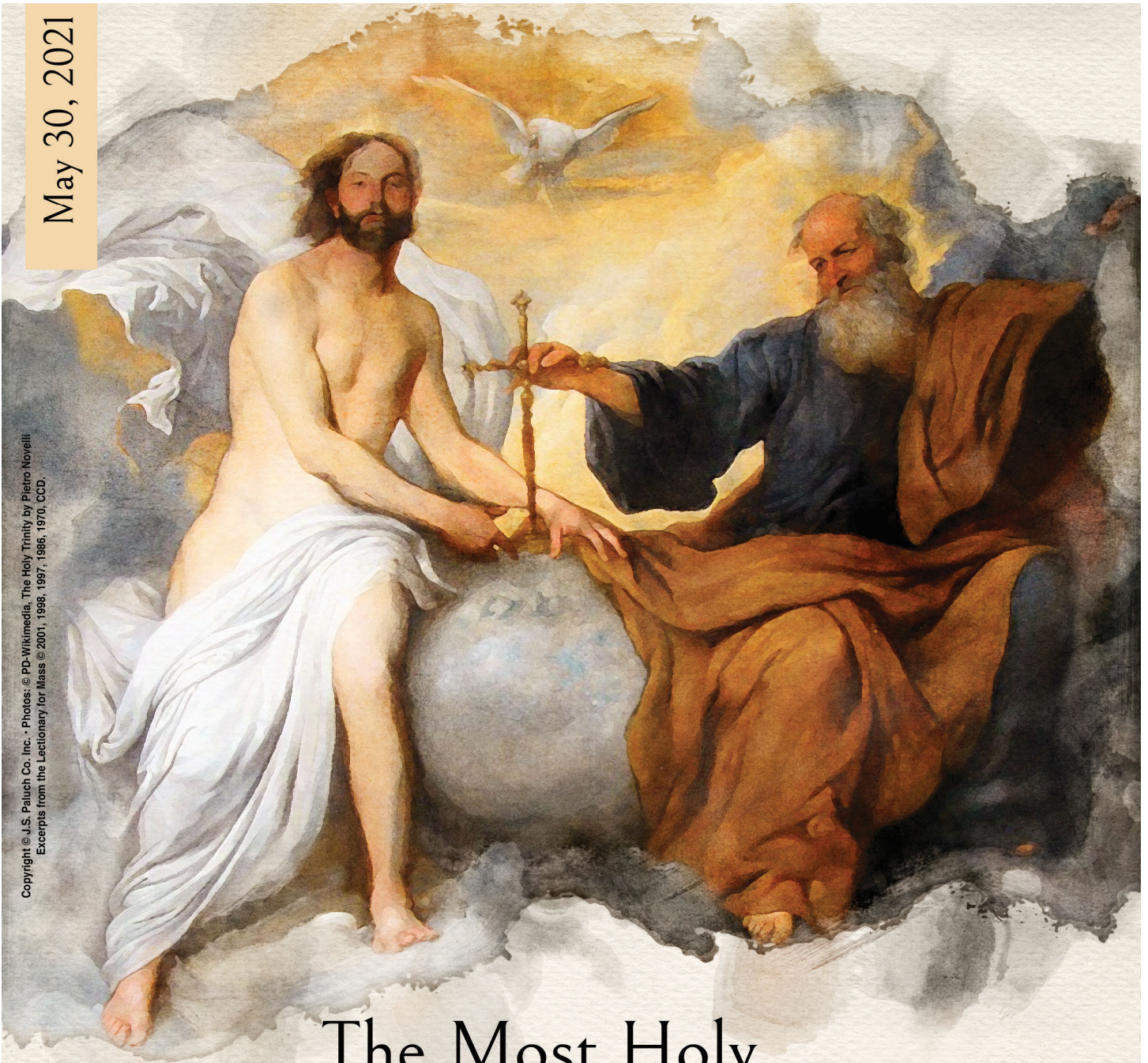

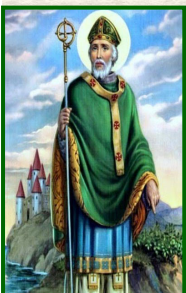

A Message from our Pastor

Honestly, I do not like any of the readings for today's celebration of the Most Holy Trinity. The readings just are not that Trinitarian in nature. We do have to remember that we know God is a Trinity of three persons in one being through revelation. Jesus tells us this is so, and this is also how we get the baptismal formula of baptizing in the Name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

But if we go all the way back to Genesis chapter 18, there is a very curious story about God. The chapter starts, "The LORD appeared to Abraham by the oak of Mamre, as he sat in the entrance of his tent, while the day was growing hot. Looking up, he saw three men standing near him. When he saw them, he ran from the entrance of the tent to greet them; and bowing to the ground, he said:

"Sir, if it please you, do not go on past your servant." (Gen 18: 1-3)

Abraham is resting under an oak tree and he sees three men, so he asks them to stay with him so that he can give them hospitality. The men accepted his offer and stayed with him and promised him a child, at which Sara, his wife laughed. She even lied to God about laughing. God then tells Abraham about the future of Sodom and Gomorrah, since they had singled him out as the father of a mighty nation.

God was present in this story as three persons, but in Chapter 19 the two angels arrive at Sodom and some scholars say they were the ones with the Lord, but the text does not give details to draw that conclusion. I say that The Trinity visited Abraham - the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. They are always united and work together though their personhood is distinct from one another as well. It is a very confusing and deep thought, but here we see a version of our very Trinitarian theology through the Old Testament. God has revealed that God is a Trinity of persons.

The idea of the Trinity is a complex process of theology, and many scholars, even the great St. Augustine, have a hard time explaining it. Each person is distinct and can be enjoyed on their own, but they are always together as well. You can't have one member without the presence of the others. The Trinity is a great mystery of our faith. We may never be able to fully explain it, but we can appreciate it. If you do not understand the Trinity, I encourage you to make a little study. You will be glad that you did.

May St. Patrick pray for us!
