## A Message from our Pastor

Today we have The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, a feast that is very special to the church and celebrates most intentionally, the Blessed Sacrament. The church tells us over and over again in her documents that the Eucharist is the “source and summit” of our faith. You can find this in the Vatican II document Sacrosanctum Concilium and the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

The source and summit of our faith is Jesus himself, and everything is built on the foundation of Jesus Christ. This includes the Eucharist that Jesus gave us, so when we come to the Mass, we need to remember that the Mass is not an event, but an act of prayer and worship. The Eucharist is central to the prayer and worship in the Mass, as the receiving of the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ himself is what happens.

The first part of the Mass - the Liturgy of the Word - prepares us for the reception of Jesus in the second part of the Mass - the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Therefore, since the Eucharist is really Jesus, Jesus remains our firm foundation. The Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharistic bread is Jesus's enduring presence in our lives, and we experience this presence each time we come to Mass.

But many Catholics no longer believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This fact really is a shame. We have become so secularized and scientific in society that we do not believe in the Eucharist. But the Eucharist really is what Jesus says it is: His Body and Blood given up for us and what we do in remembrance of him. The Mass is the very act of worship that Jesus asks his disciples to carry out throughout the whole world.

One young man, who was born in London but grew up in Naples, told us that the Eucharist is our “highway to heaven.” Blessed Carlo Acutis spent three years of his life categorizing all of the Eucharistic Miracles of the world so that he could share them with his friends, who did not believe in the Eucharist. It was the last 3 years of his life, as Leukemia took him at the age of 15. This young man was a catechist for his church and would spend many hours in prayer before the Eucharist. It was this love of spending time with God in the Eucharist that led him to create websites devoted to the Eucharistic Miracles, and he also worked on categorizing all of the Marian apparitions as well.

This young man's desire to share his love of Jesus in the Eucharist has now travelled around the world and people. *(continued on the next page)*

(continued from previous page) transformed many His act of service was his desire to share the best thing ever: Jesus. Not just any Jesus, but Jesus in the Eucharist. This should give us something to think about - is my faith in line with Blessed Carlo? What can I learn from this 15 year old?

If you struggle with the idea of the Real Presence of Christ, I ask you to do 2 things. First, pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament and ask for faith. Second, attend Mass as often as you can - even daily - and see if it makes a difference in your life. I can't imagine life without daily Mass, but that's part of the reason I'm a priest.

May Blessed Mary, Woman of the Eucharist, pray for us!
